



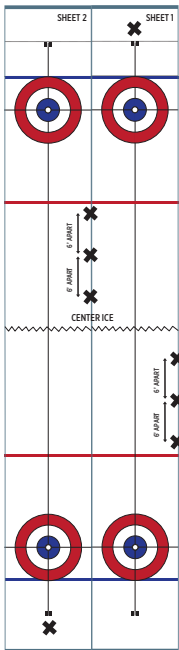
## Rules for Play During Covid-19



### ON THE ICE

**MASK ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES WHILE PLAYING**

#### NON-DELIVERING TEAM POSITIONS



**GAMES WILL START ON  
OPPOSITE ENDS**

Drawmasters will determine the manner of assigning all hammer and stone colors.

The winning team (or team who had hammer last) must clean the rocks and the scoreboard at the conclusion of the game. We will use disinfecting wipes for this process. Only ice technicians and designated members should handle ice making equipment. When cleaning ice, players doing the cleaning should follow these steps: Remove gloves. Sanitize hands. Clean ice. Sanitize hands again.

Please use your own equipment for curling (Broom, stabilizer, grippers, step-on slider). The proshop will be open for members to purchase any needed equipment.

No handshakes or elbow bumps. A simple “Good Curling” or “Good luck” will suffice.

Sheets 1 and 3 will begin each draw on the scoreboard end. Sheets 2 and 4 will begin play at the glass end.

Only Thirds / Vice Skips are to interact with scoreboards.

You can use your feet or a broom to move any rock not in play, but the only use your hands to move rocks if they are the rocks you are throwing.

When measuring, players doing the measure should follow these steps. Remove gloves. Sanitize hands. Do measurement. Sanitize hands again.

Only one sweeper per stone. No relaying the sweep (sweeper switches with teammate halfway down the ice). Skip/Vice-Skip also should not assist sweeping.

The Skip/Vice must move away from the sweeper coming down the ice to ensure social distancing.

Non-delivering team Skip/Vice may not enter the house until opposing Skip/Vice relinquishes control. You may not sweep your opponent’s stone behind the tee line. If the rock is swept accidentally, the non-offending skip can place the rock back where they thought it would have ended. Non-delivering team locations. Skip stands behind the playing end Hack. Sweepers stand near the center of the ice on the side of the sheet towards the wall on sheet 1. Next to deliver can be at the delivering end courtesy line. Spots will be marked on the ice for suggested places to stand. Always social distance from other players on your sheet and neighboring sheets.

“Community” water pitchers WILL NOT be provided. Please bring your own water bottle or order a single serve item from the bar.
