Vaccines and Masks

Greater Midland and all of its operating units continue to be fully aligned with MIOSHA guidelines as it relates to COVID protection, specifically around mask wearing and social distancing. At this time, for those that are not fully vaccinated, a mask is recommended. Also, according to the most current CDC guidelines, a mask is recommended for everyone, even if vaccinated.
